Work with assigned departments to create and expand CZS volunteer engagement initiatives and projects. 4. Other related duties as assigned, including tasks related to volunteer recruitment and special events planning.
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum one year of college at an accredited institution; G.P.A. 2.5/4.0 majoring in non-profit management, communications, psychology, sociology, human resources management or related field. • Experience as a volunteer in any setting • Minimum 18 years of age. • Completion of a reflective journal or project required as part of internship. • Strong interpersonal communications and organizational skills. • Strong computer skills. • Must be able to commit to 12 weeks; approximately 40 hours/week.
