MAKING A PLANNED GIFT TO THE CHICAGO ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY/BROOKFIELD ZOO

Generally any gift made with forethought about its benefit to the charity and the financial implications to the donor and the donor's family is a planned gift. Planned gifts are often achieved through a legal document. Wills, living trusts, life insurance, retirement plans, charitable gift annuities and charitable remainder trusts are all used to plan gifts.

In addition, planned gifts may provide tax benefits for the donor or the donor's estate.
