Rainforest Aviary Feeding Adventure

Zoo admission and parking are NOT included in the Adventure price.

Greetings - Welcome to the Rainforest Aviary Feeding Adventure!

On this Adventure, you will assist our animal care specialists in preparing the food for the 12:00 noon feeding of our rainforest birds in Feathers & Scales. You will learn how we present the different foods to accommodate the different feeding habits of each species. Once the preparations are complete, you will assist the staff with placing the food in the habitat. The care staff will provide you with instructions on how to safely move through the rain forest and interact with the resident birds.

As the different birds come down to eat, you will be able to learn which foods are the favorites of the different species. Animal care staff will identify each of the different species as they arrive at the feeding stations and you will help them conduct part of their daily inventory. You will learn how and why the staff does these daily inventories.

At the end of the Adventure, after the rainforest birds have had their fill, you will bid them farewell and exit the habitat with staff. The care staff will answer any additional questions you have as they guide you back to the public area of the building.

Being an animal care specialist takes careful preparation. Here are some things you need to know so that you can be prepared to work side by side with your Flying Feathered Friends zoo crew.

Communication between you and the host care staff is crucial. You must be able to read, speak, and understand English without the use of an interpreter. If you are unable to participate in the program without an interpreter, please call (708) 688-8338.

You must be attentive. Although our birds regularly work with their human caregivers, they are still wild animals and their behavior is unpredictable. It is important that you pay close attention to the guidance and instructions of the animal care specialist you are spending the morning with. Never enter any animal area without direction from the care staff. Always wait for instructions and authorization from the staff before approaching any of the animals while participating in observation, care and enrichment, and feeding sessions. Participants must be able to maneuver within the rainforest habitat.

All participants are required to complete a signed liability waiver (page 5).

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can register for Flying Feathered Friends?

- **Age**
Participants must be at least 8 years old. A parent or adult guardian must accompany participants under the age of 17.
- **Maximum Group Size**
Each Adventure is limited to 2 Participants. Two underage participants can register as long as a parent or guardian checks them in.

Can I take pictures during the program?

To keep the animals comfortable and to ensure the safety of all involved, we do not allow camera or cell phone use during Backstage Adventures. While you are in the habitat, if you wish family members or friends will be able to take pictures for you from the guest areas located in front of the habitat. No photos can be taken in any non-public area.

Where do we meet?

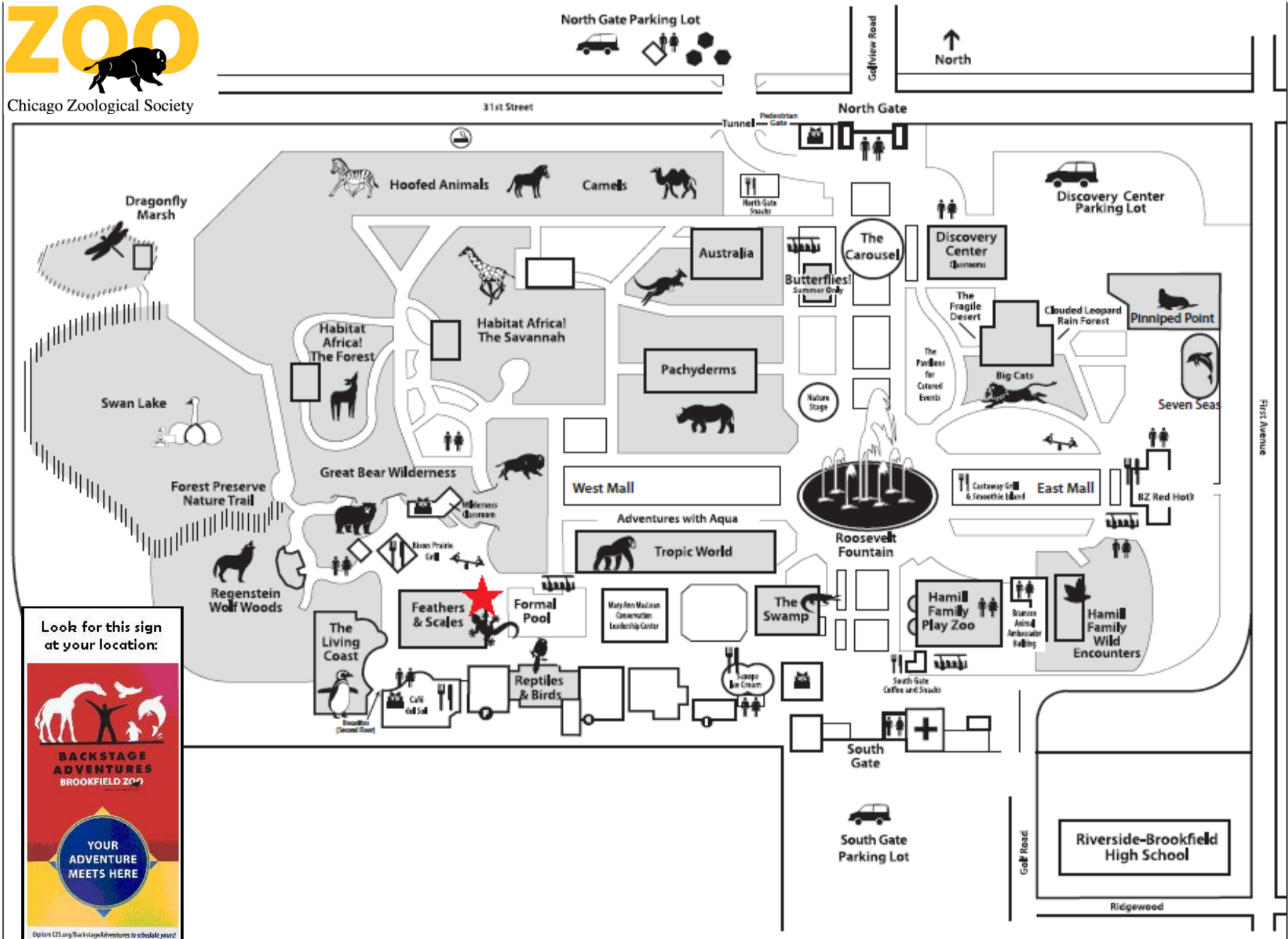
An animal care specialist will meet you at the public entrance of *Feathers and Scales* house at the sign that reads "Your Backstage Adventure Meets Here" promptly at 11:45 a.m.

You must be on Time.

Since you will be participating with a scheduled public feeding this Adventure must start on time. If you are late, the feeding will proceed without you. Participants that do not show up for their registered session or choose to leave early will not be granted a refund. Refunds are only available 14 calendar days before the program date and there will be a non-refundable 25% deposit for each program.

Please be aware that though it is rare, Backstage Adventures can be cancelled by Brookfield Zoo at any time due to animal welfare, dangerous weather, or staff needs. If your program is cancelled, you will be contacted with as much notice as possible to schedule another date for your adventure. Please note that due to the great diversity of

bird species here at Brookfield Zoo and their wide variety of needs, especially as the seasons change, the birds pictured in this packet are not guaranteed to be part of your Backstage Adventure program.

Rainforest Aviary Feeding Adventure Program Participant Waiver

I understand that I will be entering animal enclosures as part of the Rainforest Aviary Feeding Backstage Adventure (the "Program"). I UNDERSTAND THAT THE PROGRAM IS INHERENTLY DANGEROUS, AND I HEREBY WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE CHICAGO ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY, THE BROOKFIELD ZOO AND THEIR RESPECTIVE EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS AND TRUSTEES, RELATED TO OR ARISING FROM THE PROGRAM.

I consent to the use of my likeness in photographic, digital or electronic media by the Chicago Zoological Society in connection with the Program.

I attest that I meet the following requirements for the Program:

- I am at least 8 years of age.
- I possess the ability to read, speak and understand English without the use of an interpreter.
- I am not pregnant.
- I understand that if I am 17 years old or younger, I must have a parent or guardian report to the Program with me for an introduction and sign my liability waiver.
- I will not enter an animal area without direction from the Animal Care staff and I will wait for instructions and authorization from the Animal Care staff before attempting to touch the animals.
- If I haven't done so prior to my arrival, I will remove all jewelry (smooth wedding bands excepted) prior to going to the exhibit area. Prescription lenses worn for vision correction are acceptable.
- I will not carry a personal camera.
- I understand that if I am under the influence of alcoholic beverages or any type of controlled substance I will forfeit my right to participate in the Flying Feathered Friends Program.
- I attest that I am in good general health and physical condition, suitable for Program participation.

I understand that the Chicago Zoological Society reserves the right to cancel the Program at any time where the best interest of the animals is concerned. I also understand that it is the animal's choice to participate in the program. I understand that I will be removed from the Program for failure to comply with the established rules and guidelines as set forth here, as established by the Chicago Zoological Society and as communicated by the Animal Care staff members.
