VETERINARY TECHNICIAN INTERN/EXTERN

This position contributes to the success of the Chicago Zoological Society by providing technical and medical support to the veterinary staff for the care provided to the animal collection and hospitalized patients.

These positions are physically demanding, and student may be subjected to a variety of physical demands and environmental factors and exposures.
