### **Session Details:**

#### Complete the Feet!

Complete the Feet! is an onsite Zoo activity that challenges students to observe, ask questions, and use evidence to support claims about animal feet characteristics and uses. This class provides strategies and lesson materials to engage students in investigation of mammal and bird feet adaptation in the classroom before and after their visit as well during their fieldtrip to Brookfield Zoo. Teachers learn strategies to support close observation through observational sketching, analysis, argumentation from evidence, peer discussion, and evaluating, and revising claims. (In cases where field trips are not possible, materials and strategies can be adapted to support animal study in classroom settings.)
