The winner of the art contest will be announced at the end of the celebration, and will receive a unique close encounter with Humboldt penguins at Brookfield Zoo for two people. The winning entry, along with other select entries, will be displayed in the offices of Cook County Commissioners Luis Arroyo and Jesus "Chuy" Garcia during Hispanic Heritage Month.
