#### **Organizational Overview**

The Chicago Zoological Society (CZS) is a private nonprofit organization that operates Brookfield Zoo on land owned by the Forest Preserve District of Cook County. Opened to the public in 1934, Brookfield Zoo has been a Chicago-area treasure and family destination for more than 75 years. Brookfield Zoo is the largest suburban attraction in Cook County, both in size and visitation. The 216-acre Zoo annually serves over two million visitors from the diverse Chicago metropolitan area. The zoo is open 365 days a year. On an average day, more than 11,000 people visit during the Zoo's peak attendance season in the summer months.

The Chicago Zoological Society's mission is to inspire conservation leadership by connecting people with wildlife and nature. We strive to provide people of all ages and backgrounds with opportunities to learn about and care for the natural world. When it first opened, Brookfield Zoo was considered "cutting edge" for its bar-less enclosures. #### **Project or Product Description**

CZS is seeking a contractor to provide technical support services for our current fire alarm system specific to the NFPA required annual testing and equipment inspections. Testing and inspection services are to include the following:

- Smoke detector sensitivity testing to be performed in accordance with NFPA 72 guidelines, using the manufactures recommend test methods and must be completed using a UL approved testing device.
- Water flow testing of all sprinkler systems in accordance with NFPA 25. There are 71 current water flow switches installed on CZS sprinkler systems.
- Contractor will be responsible for providing two (2) dedicated technicians, with the appropriate certifications and qualification, to test and inspect the current Siemens fire alarm system using NFPA recommended testing frequencies and methods.

- o Smoke detector sensitivity testing and analysis of findings to include any recommendations for equipment replacement or cleaning.
- Report to be provided to CZS in hardbound format and electronic format (PDF or Word file is acceptable).

#### **Schematics, timeline (If applicable)**

- Annual Inspection to be scheduled for October/November 2018. CZS Safety Department will coordinate with contractor the dates for the inspection. CZS will then create a detailed inspection schedule for each day and will provide this schedule to the Contractor prior to work commencing. It is critical to CZS operations and the welfare of the animal collection that the schedule for this work be strictly adhered to in order to prevent any delays during the dates of inspection/testing.
- Inspection takes approximately four (4) weeks to complete and technicians will require an escort in all structures and facilities on property by one of the CZS Safety Department team members or other designated CZS staff member.
- The current fire alarm system has a total of 38 panels which provide protection for more than 50 structures.

All proposal responses for the RFP are due no later than Friday, August 10th, 2018.

CZS will award the contract to the proposal which demonstrates the best combination of price and proven reliability, references from other jobs similar in complexity to CZS and experience.
